

<u>News from the Post Adjutant/</u> Membership Chairperson

Thank you to all of you who came in and paid or picked up your membership cards. I will again host Tuesday Membership days. I will be at the Post on Tuesdays in October from 12:10 until 4:00. That will allow you to get your membership card and Early Bird sticker on the spot. The Early Bird sticker entitles you to a turkey dinner on Sunday, Nov. 9th at the Post. That also includes the S.A.L. members who are early birds. The member is free and it is \$10.00 for your guest. Neither long program nor speeches; start with Andy's manhattans at 1:00 and dinner and fellowship at 2:00. Also, thank you to those who mailed a self-addressed stamped envelope with your check. That saved the Post money and me time. Even a return label is helpful.

If you are over 70 years of age and are Grand Fathered, meaning that the Post pays your dues, and have not received your card, please give me a call (586 202-0646 or 586 286- 2801).

The membership process is a long one. Let me try to explain it. I receive your payment, record it, and send you your card. Then your information is mailed (and paid) to Department. Department processes it and sends it (with payment) to National. Hopefully they get to it as quickly as I do. If not, in the meantime, National is sending you another renewal notice. If you have your card from me, ignore that notice. If you have any questions, call me before you pay again. By the time everyone is paid, Department, District, and National, the Post is left with \$7.50 a member to pay bills, repairs, and continue to function. Be reassured that your Officers are diligent about stretching your money.

To be a member in Good Standing, your dues need to be paid and recorded by Dec. 31, 2014. Starting Jan. 1, 2015 the staff is instructed to check all cards to reassure that your Lounge privileges are current.

Veteran's Day is Tuesday, Nov. 11. Celebrate! You have earned this day. Start the day at the Post for services. Local businesses express their thanks for your service by offering free dinners, car wash, haircut, discounts and more. Be proud, show your Legion card.

Another opportunity to celebrate is Saturday, Nov. 8th at the Detroit Veteran's Day Parade. This year's event will commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War. Hopefully, you have already read about it in the Sept. 2014 issue of MI Legionnaire.

What: A light lunch will be provided by the S.A.L. (Sons of the American Legion). Activities include a visit from Santa, craft time, Tootsee the Balloon Artist, and a train ride (Voiture 1061 40/8).

Age: Acceptable ages are Birth to 10 years old.

Admissions will be with tickets only, both adults and children will need one. The tickets will be mailed to the FIRST 150 PEOPLE TO REGISTER BY NOV. 21ST. Tickets will be mailed by the first week in December. Santa will arrive in the train with a gift for each child 10 and under. The money to purchase the gifts, is generated from donations collected in the Lounge and 50/50 raffles from various functions. We regret that our building can only accommodate 150 people. We recognize that this is a family event (and should be) but we ask that you limit the number of adults attending. In the event of a large crowd, if you have more than two adults in your party, perhaps Dad or Grandpa could wait in the lounge until Santa arrives, and then join the family in time to take pictures. Our goal is to have as many children as possible attend. Remember that the event will be closed when registration reaches 150 people or no later than Nov. 21st, whichever comes first.
